Stewardship

1. God owns it all. What are we freely giving/tithing?
2. God partners with us/stewards. What are we creating?
3. God's priorities are those in need. Whose needs are we meeting?

Personal Reflections – daily, weekly, monthly, annually

1. What are we giving (supporting, thanking)?
2. What gifts does God seek from us – to create God's vision?
3. Whose life is better because of me?

ADVENT

1. Is our giving a preparation for Jesus?
2. Is our giving compassionate toward creation?
3. Is our giving spread to all or expressing God's priorities?

CHRISTMAS/EPIPHANY

1. God gives us a present
2. How do we care for God's child?
3. Who do we share this present with?

LENT

1. How do we acknowledge God's ownership?
2. Searching deeper for our gifts
3. Seek the hurting, making room in your heart

EASTER

1. God has a master plan
2. God connects humanity with the divine
3. The Kingdom is open to all (disabilities, sufferers, etc.)

PENTECOST

1. God intended diversity
2. God uses all of us – a good steward
3. God's love is for everyone, including those who feel different

PENTECOST II

1. Harvest belongs to God
2. God's love multiplies our gifts
3. Gleaning – who gets the fruits?
