Using the right resources for the right type of project is an important element of planned giving and personal financial stewardship. For example, while Pledges for annual commitments are typically funded from yearly income resources, Capital Campaigns and Endowment Funds are more appropriate for gifts from assets. The use of assets appropriately can reduce taxes and grow giving just by being strategic.
